The components of experiential-learning assignments vary to some degree, but show that most students have regularly practised transferable skills. Experiential learning is based on four main elements, which operate in a continuous cycle during the learning experience: Concrete experience Reflective observation Abstract conceptualization Active experimentation The components of experiential Experienced at Learning assignments vary Experienced at Learning some degree, but generally follow the following criteria: The project should be personally meaningful and have some significance to the student Students should have opportunities to reflect on and discuss their learning experience throughout the process of the assignment

The experience should involve the student's whole person, including the senses, personality, and emotions Previous knowledge on the subject matter should be acknowledged
